Victorian Treasure Pouch

Materials: 1 skein Aracania Ulmo Multi
1 fat quarter or 5/8 yard fabric for lining

Hook: Size C & E or D & F for larger bag

Gauge: 4.5 dc = 1"

Abbreviations & Terms

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
rnd = round
dc = double crochet
rep = repeat
shell = 5 dc in same st
sc = single crochet

Bag

FORM CIRCLE: With smaller hook ch 4, join with a sl st in first ch or wrap yarn around index finger and work 1 ch in loop.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 11 dc in circle. Join to top of ch 3 with sl st. (12 dc)
Rnd 2: Ch 3, 2 dc in each dc around, join. (24 dc)
Rnd 3: Ch 3, 1 dc in ch 3 space, *1 dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc* rep around, join (36 dc)
Rnd 4: Ch 3, 1 dc in ch 3 space, *1 dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc* rep around, join (48 dc)
Rnd 5: Ch 3, 1 dc in ch 3 space, *1 dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc* rep around, join (60 dc)
Rnd 6: Ch 3, 1 dc in ch 3 space, *1 dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc*, rep around, join (72 dc)

Rnd 7: Ch 3, *1 dc in bk lp of next dc* rep around, join (72 dc)
Rnd 8: Ch 3, 2 dc in ch 3 space (half shell made), *ch 1, skip 1 dc, 9 dc, ch 1, skip 1 dc, work 5 dc shell in next dc* rep around. End 2 dc in ch 3 sp, join. (64 dc, 6 shells)
Rnd 9 - 22: Ch 3, 2 dc in ch 3 space, *ch 1, skip 1 dc, 9 dc, ch 1, skip 2 dc, work 5 dc shell in next dc, ch 1 skip 2 dc* rep around. End 2 dc in ch 3 sp, join.

BEADING ROW: Ch 4, * sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, ch1* rep around joining in 3rd ch f ch 4.

NEXT RND: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, *sc in next dc, 5 dc in next dc* rep to end, 2 dc in ch 3 sp, join. Fasten off leaving a 4" tail.

DRAWSTRING: With larger hook and yarn doubled, work two 36" long ch.

FINISHING: Weave in ends. Weave drawstrings through beading row.

OPTIONAL LINING: Cut a piece of fabric 18 x 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ "or size to fit your bag. Sew $\frac{5}{8}$ " seam along one long edge. Press seam open. Turn lining on fold line and press. Open lining up and sew a gathering stitch along the pressed fold line. Draw up gathering threads tightly. Stitch across gathering stitches. Turn lining so that wrong sides are together. Stitch raw edges together at $\frac{5}{8}$ ". Using this as a guide turn raw edges under $\frac{1}{4}$ " twice. Stitch. Hand stitch lining to bag just below beading row. Catch stitch lining to bottom of bag to hold in place.
